Health Benefits	Coverage	
Prescription Drug	100%	Maximum of \$5,000 per benefit year. Based on the National Formulary with a generic rider. Dispensing fees are not covered.
Vision	100%	Combined maximum of \$120 every 24 months for one eye exam, glasses and/or contact lenses.
Chiropractor, Naturopath and Physiotherapist* Practitioners	80%	Combined maximum of \$500 per benefit year. *Physician's prescription required.
Psychologist, Social Worker and/or Registered Psychotherapist	80%	Combined maximum of \$750 per benefit year.
Ambulance	100%	Based on reasonable and customary charges.
Custom-Made Orthotics	80%	Maximum of \$300 every 24 months *Prescription required. Prescription can be prescribed by a Physician, Podiatrist, or Chiropracist.
Dental Accident	100%	Maximum of \$1,000 per benefit year. Services must be performed within 12 months of accident. Pre-authorization required.
Diaphragms, IUD's, Cervical Caps	100%	Excludes insertion fee.
Prosthetics	100%	Based on reasonable and customary charges.
Trusses, Crutches, Splints & Braces	80%	Limited to \$450 per benefit year. Prescription & pre-authorization may be required. Not solely for athletic use.
Tutorial	100%	Limited to \$15 per hour to a maximum of \$1,000 per disability (after 15 days confinement due to injury or illness).
Wigs and Hairpieces	100%	Limited to \$500 every 24 months. As a result of Alopecia Universalis, Chemotherapy, or Radiation therapy.

Dental Benefits

Please submit an estimate/pre-authorization prior to specialist services and any dental treatment plan exceeding \$300.

Annual Maximum - \$600 per benefit year

Diagnostic & Preventative	100%	Limited to once per benefit year. Scaling up to 2 units.
Minor Restorative	80%	Fillings.
Oral Surgery	75%	Extractions.
